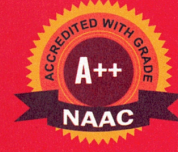

Developed under the Ministry of Education, it offers a unified, cloud-based, and open-source ERP platform that replaces fragmented systems with a single, integrated solution.

The platform follows a modular structure, covering diverse areas such as finance and accounts, academics, administration, hostel management, human resources, research projects, alumni relations, and student services. Each module is designed to automate processes, reduce manual workload, improve transparency, and enhance overall efficiency.

Samarth ERP is being implemented in central universities, state universities, IITs, IIITs, and other institutions nationwide. By bringing all core functions — from admissions and examinations to payroll and research management — onto one platform, it eliminates duplication, ensures data consistency, and supports better decision-making. Recent rollouts have shown significant impact, with institutions reporting cost savings, faster processing times, and improved accessibility for students and faculty. Statewide adoption is growing rapidly, and many universities are phasing out private ERP systems in favor of Samarth. Its cloud-based architecture also ensures scalability, security, and centralized updates, making it a sustainable digital governance solution for the future of Indian higher education.

ABOUT PMU

The Project Management Unit (PMU) was established in May 2021 by Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak. The objective of PMU is to address all application software-related needs of the University. Before its establishment, software development jobs were outsourced, but in-house development by PMU has significantly benefited the University by ensuring timely execution of projects, a manifold increase in productivity, and substantial financial savings (approximately ₹1 crore annually).

It is worth mentioning that PMU has been instrumental in implementing the Samarth ERP across the University, working tirelessly with the Samarth team in New Delhi as well as with various departments of the University. Through its dedicated efforts, PMU has set a strong foundation for digital transformation. It continues to play a pivotal role in driving innovation, efficiency, and technological self-reliance within the University.






CSJMU BEFORE & AFTER SAMARTH

Before the implementation of the Samarth ERP system at CSJMU, several key services of the university were managed through independent software platforms. Modules such as hostel management, finance, library services, inventory, and estate management all operated on separate systems, developed or procured at different times, and maintained by their respective departments. While these systems were functional for their individual purposes, they were not interconnected, which meant there was no single platform providing a unified view of operations.

This lack of integration often resulted in duplication of work and delays in coordination. For example, the hostel management system maintained records of room allotments and occupancy, while the finance system handled hostel fee transactions. Since these two systems did not communicate directly, reconciliation had to be done manually, which was both time-consuming and prone to errors. Similarly, library membership and usage records existed in isolation from other administrative modules, and inventory or asset management systems were updated independently, without automated links to financial records.

The absence of a common platform meant that staff had to manage multiple logins, learn different user interfaces, and follow separate workflows for related tasks. Generating a comprehensive report, such as a combined overview of hostel occupancy, fee status, and resource usage, required pulling data from several systems and manually compiling it. This not only slowed down decision-making but also made it harder to ensure real-time accuracy across departments.

With the introduction of Samarth ERP, all these services are now integrated into a single, cohesive system. Information flows seamlessly between modules, eliminating the need for repeated data entry and manual reconciliation. Staff can now work within a unified environment, reports can be generated instantly, and the university benefits from greater efficiency, transparency, and coordination across its operations.

ACADEMICS & STUDENT LIFECYCLE ON SAMARTH

- **Programme Management** – Manage Programmes by defining Course Curriculum and evaluation Rules. This module is essential for starting with student lifecycle management.
- **Student** – The Student Module captures each student details such as enrolled programmes, attendance, courses selected, personal details, fee payment details, grade card, transcript and so forth.
- **Admissions** – Enables the institution/HEI to configure the admission settings in Samarth and provides an interactive interface for admission processing. Goal: smooth registration and application for students.
- **Evaluation & Grading** – Apply examination rules, collaborate with paper setters and evaluators, manage exam schedules and centres, process scores and generate results, record student progression.
- **Hostel Management** – Manage hostel admissions, list hostel services for residents, and carry out billing for services.
- **Convocation** – Manage convocation events: allow graduands and families to enrol, handle ticketing and seat allocation, and communicate with attendees.
- **Alumni Management** – Build and retain an alumni database; engage alumni to foster professional networking opportunities.
- **Student Feedback Management System** – Allows students to submit feedback on faculty and course/subject.
- **Certificate Management** – Student services such as Digital Degree, Marksheet, Provisional, Migration certification, etc.
- **Training and Placement** – Connect with industries/firms seeking a skilled workforce; list opportunities for students; allow students to apply.
- **Managed LMS/VLE** – Deployment and integration of MOODLE and other open-source LMS with SAMARTH on cloud.

EMPLOYEE LIFECYCLE ON SAMARTH

- **Employee Management System / HR (PIS)** – Manage and organize employee information.
- **Recruitment** – Conduct online recruitment for teaching and non-teaching posts.
- **Leave Management** – Record and monitor leaves per government policies; add leave types; customize approval workflows; provide real-time leave balances and application status for staff and administration.
- **Payroll Management** – Calculate, generate, and approve salaries per policies across pay grades and pay levels.
- **Knowledge Management System** – Track knowledge created by staff and students (research publications, papers, patents, etc.).
- **Career Advancement Scheme** – Employees apply under APAR (Annual Performance Appraisal), PBAS (Performance Based Appraisal), and CAS (Career Advancement Scheme Based Appraisal).
- **Training of Trainers (ToT) Management** – Admin schedules trainings/opportunities; employees can request sessions; institution reviews requests periodically.

FINANCE & ACCOUNTS ON SAMARTH

- **Inventory Management System** – Manage records of stock items across store locations; issue and track items to employees; allow employees to request items from stores.
- **Research Project Management System** – Manage research projects and grants from funding agencies; track project/funding approvals; manage sanction orders, project accounts, and expenditures per sanctioned budget heads.
- **Finance Supply & Chain Management** – Provide budget visibility; manage requested estimates from organizational units and allocate budgets for a financial year. Accounts features support institutional and project accounts management; generate balance sheets after year-end using module statistics.
- **Bill Tracking System** – Enter bills for accounting; provide vendors an interface to track payment status.

BASE MODULES ON SAMARTH

- **User Management** – Base modules configured before any other module: define organizational structure and organigrams; create/manage users; implement Role-Based Access Control by assigning specific roles/permissions for different system functionalities.
- **Organizational Units** – Base module for defining organizational units.
- **Designation** – Base module for defining designations.

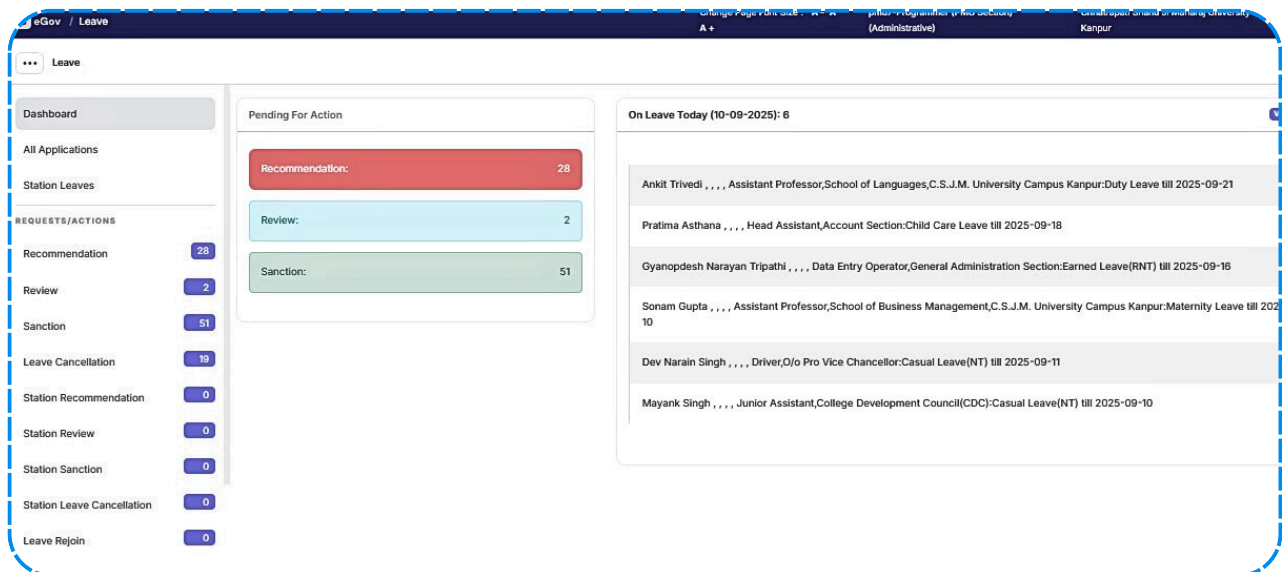
