This futuristic complex integrates multiple elite-level sports grounds and courts within a single campus—ensuring that multidisciplinary training is possible under one roof.





SPORTS POLICY – SUMMARY

The C.S.J.M. University Sports Policy aims to promote student participation in sports, build a strong sports culture, and identify talented athletes who can achieve excellence and bring recognition to the University.

i. Key Initiatives

- The Sports Scholarship Policy (2023) provides financial aid, fee concessions, and benefits to deserving athletes under the Sports Quota Admission scheme.
- A dedicated Sports Fund supports activities and infrastructure, while annual sports competitions are organized across disciplines such as athletics, aquatics, badminton, basketball, cricket, chess, hockey, table tennis, weightlifting, and yoga.
- The University also facilitates inter-collegiate and inter-university tournaments, providing travel allowances, daily allowances, refreshments, and medical reimbursements. Sports Council members, officials, and athletes receive travel and allowance support.
- Facilities are continuously upgraded, and qualified coaches are appointed to train university teams. Top performers receive awards, cash prizes, trophies, and certificates, while selected athletes and officials are provided free tracksuits and kits. Special events promoting sportsmanship are also supported.

ii. Financial Management

- Sports funds come from student and registration fees, which must be used for team participation. Unspent funds are returned to the University, and all fees are deposited in a separate sports account to ensure transparent development.

iii. Sports Quota Admissions & Scholarships

- Admission is based on performance trials and certificate verification, with final approval from the Director of Student Welfare. Scholarship holders must maintain 90% attendance, consistent performance at AllU/National/International levels, and good conduct to retain benefits.

iv. Additional Features

- The Sports Council may revise fee structures, introduce new activities, and update policies. Preference may be given to individual games. The policy emphasizes athlete motivation, recognition, insurance schemes for safety, collaboration with alumni/NRIs for funding, upgraded facilities, and structured coaching.

In summary, this policy ensures holistic sports development, motivating students and enhancing the University's prestige.



SPORTS QUOTA ADMISSION & ASSISTANCE

Sports Quota Admission

The University provides a limited number of admissions under Sports Quota each year to recognize and support talented athletes.

i. Talent-Based Admission: Selection is based on performance in recognized sports and games. Applicants undergo performance trials and certificate verification. Final decisions are made by the Director of Student Welfare.

ii. Commitment to Participation: Admitted athletes must participate in inter-university or national tournaments. Failure to participate or lack of dedication can result in loss of concessions.

- Flexible Attendance: Attendance for classes missed due to tournaments, practice, or camps is considered present upon recommendation by Physical Education officials.
- Eligibility & Benefits: Scholarships are awarded in categories (A++ to E) based on performance levels. Benefits may include:
 - Free food and accommodation in University hostels
 - Academic fee concessions (percentage varies)
 - Monthly diet allowance (for a fixed duration)

iii. Special Considerations: Potential athletes in measurable sports (time, height, distance) and team-game athletes may be considered by the Sports Selection Committee (with limited benefits).

iv. Maintaining Scholarships: Requires 90% attendance, consistent performance at AllU/National/International levels, and good conduct.

v. Discontinuation Grounds: Scholarships may be revoked for poor attendance, non-participation, doping, misconduct, indiscipline, or criminal activity.

vi. Policy Updates: Scholarship categories and concessions are reviewed annually; preference may be given to individual games.

INTRODUCTION

The academic years 2024-25 mark a landmark period in the sporting journey of Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University (CSJMU), Kanpur, reflecting the institution's unwavering commitment to excellence, holistic athlete development, and national and international recognition. Under the visionary leadership of the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, CSJMU has successfully combined strategic governance, world-class infrastructure, professional coaching, and athlete-centered policies, resulting in outstanding performances in both team and individual sports.

Guided by the CSJMU Sports Policy 2023 and the establishment of a dedicated Sports Council, the University has taken decisive steps to promote a vibrant sports culture, ensure structured athlete support, and provide opportunities for high-performance training. Significant investments in modern infrastructure, alongside free admissions, hostel facilities, diet, and professional coaching for quota athletes, have positioned CSJMU as a pioneering institution in sports education and excellence in Uttar Pradesh and India.

With its integrated approach spanning grassroots engagement, competitive representation, and international achievements, CSJMU has enhanced student participation, nurtured emerging talent, and elevated its standing at the national and global levels. From hosting prestigious zonal tournaments to securing podium finishes at international events, the University's achievements reflect its vision of becoming a hub of sporting excellence and innovation.





EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The academic years 2023–24 and 2024–25 have been transformative for CSJMU, marking a period of rapid growth and recognition in Indian university sports. With a sharp focus on policy-driven athlete support, increased sports quota admissions, and investments in training infrastructure, CSJMU has recorded significant progress across all indicators of sporting excellence.
- Sports Policy & Governance: Implementation of CSJMU Sports Policy 2023 ensured free admission, hostel, diet, and coaching for quota athletes, supported by a newly constituted Sports Council for planning and monitoring.
- Sports Quota Admissions: In 2024–25, 81 athletes were admitted under the sports quota, with the highest representation in Football (13) and Boxing (10).

Medal Performance:

- **2023–24:** 6 medals (2 Gold, 3 Silver, 1 Bronze)
- **2024–25:** 17 medals (9 Gold, 5 Silver, 3 Bronze) → a 150% growth.

International Recognition:

- Mahi Siwach won Gold at the ASBC Asian U-22 Boxing Championship (Colombo 2025).
- Anshika represented India at the Asian Shooting Championship and was selected for the ISSF World Cup.
- National and AIU Achievements: Gold medal victories in Football, Kho-Kho, Kickboxing, and Boxing, along with consistent podium finishes in Wrestling, Weightlifting, Shooting, and Taekwondo.
- Khelo India University Games (KIUG): A record 34 athletes from CSJMU qualified for KIUG 2024–25, marking a milestone in competitive representation.
- Sports Culture: With 527 athletes participating in 51 university-level tournaments and hosting prestigious zonal championships, CSJMU has cultivated a vibrant sports ecosystem on campus.
- Infrastructure: Development of world-class facilities including a BCCI-standard cricket stadium, astroturf hockey field, WA-approved athletics track, multipurpose indoor halls, and a modern gymnasium, positioning CSJMU as a regional hub for national and international events.
- This report highlights the University's governance, policy implementation, sports quota admissions, achievements, events, infrastructure, athlete development, and national-level participation.

SPORTS QUOTA ADMISSIONS (2024-25)

In alignment with the CSJMU Sports Policy 2023, the University granted admissions under the Sports Quota across multiple disciplines. These admissions were made over and above the existing categories, ensuring wider participation and opportunities for talented athletes. Each admitted athlete received a comprehensive support package, including free admission, hostel accommodation, diet, coaching, and training facilities, fostering holistic development.

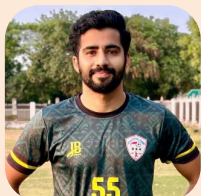

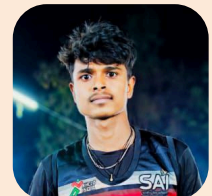

सीएसजेएमयू से एफिलिएटेड कॉलेजों में वोकेशनल कोर्स की फीस बढ़कर देना

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KANPUR (1 June): सीएसजेएमयू यूनिवर्सिटी से एफिलिएटेड कॉलेजों में चलने वाले वोकेशनल कोर्स के लिए स्टूडेंट्स को अब डबल फीस चुकानी होगी. कॉलेजों के प्रिंसिपल्स के अनुरोध पर फीस को 250 से बढ़कर 500 कर दिया गया है. इसके अलावा कॉलेजों में चल रहे सभी कोर्सेज में स्पोर्ट्स कोटे से दो सीटें (सुपरन्यूमेरी) पर एडमिशन दिया जाएगा. एकेडमिक कार्डिनल की मीटिंग में यह डिसेशन लिया गया है.



यह डिसेशन न्यू एकेडमिक सेसन से लागू कर दिए जाएंगे.

6 महीने से 1 साल के कोर्स

एफिलिएटेड कॉलेजों में स्टूडेंट्स को न्यू एजुकेशन पॉलिसी के तहत वोकेशनल कोर्स पढ़ाए जा रहे हैं. यूनिवर्सिटी की ओर से 40 कोर्सेज

को लिस्ट को फाइनल किया गया है. इन्हीं लिस्ट के अनुसार कोर्सेज को सिलेक्ट करके कॉलेजों में चलाया जाता है. इन कोर्सेज को चलाए जाने का उद्देश्य स्टूडेंट्स को ऐसी एजुकेशन देना है, जिसके बाद वह अपने पैरों पर खड़े हो सकें. कोर्स हफ महीने से लेकर एक साल तक के हैं.

फीस में 100% तक घट सीएसजेएमयू की स्पोर्ट्स पॉलिसी के अनुसार स्पोर्ट्स प्लेयर को अलग अलग कैटेगरी में बांटा गया है. इन प्लेयर्स को अभी तक सीएसजेएमयू फीस में स्पोर्ट्स कोटे से एडमिशन मिलता था. अब वह कोटे कॉलेजों में चलने वाले सभी कोर्सेज में लागू होगा. एकेडमिक कार्डिनल में तय हुआ कि कॉलेजों में चलने वाले सभी कोर्सेज में दो सीटें को स्पोर्ट्स कोटे से रिजर्व किया जाएगा. इन दो सुपर न्यूमेरी सीट्स पर स्पोर्ट्स प्लेयर को एडमिशन मिलेगा. कैटेगरी ए प्लेस प्लेयर को 100 परसेंट फीस में घट मिलेगी. वहीं कैटेगरी बी प्लेस को फीस में 80 परसेंट घट मिलेगी. अलग कैटेगरी के स्टूडेंट्स को अलग अलग घट दिए जाने का प्रावधान है.
