B. Pharm. Entrance Guidelines for Candidates

Important Instructions

1. The admission for B. Pharm. program will be conducted through entrance examination on 26.05.2025 in the School of Pharmaceutical Sciences.
2. The candidate should be registered for B. Pharm. through the admission portal at www.csjmu.ac.in.
3. If the candidate is unable to register for the program at the admission portal till 23.05.2025, then under no circumstances, the candidate shall be allowed to appear in the Entrance.
4. Fees deposited at the time of registration will not be refunded under any circumstances.
5. In case, the candidate is unable to appear at the due date for the Entrance, eligibility of the candidate shall be cancelled.
6. Candidates must ensure to remain updated of the important dates of the admission process displayed on official website www.csjmu.ac.in. The University/ Department shall bear no responsibility in case the student is negligent in appearing on due dates.

7. The merit list of the qualified candidates for admission to the B. Pharm Program shall be published on the official University Website.

Entrance

1. The Entrance shall be conducted by the way of MCQs with four choices or options. Candidate has to select one appropriate choice among four options.
2. The syllabus of the question paper will consist of 10+2 (Science Stream) Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics /Biology.
3. There will be 30 multiple choice questions of 03 marks each and time will be 60 mins. The question paper will be in English medium. There will be no negative marking on wrong attempt of question.

Admission

1. Admission eligibility will be determined based on the candidate's performance in the entrance examination. After declaration of the merit/rank a copy of the list will be displayed on the University website (www.csjmu.ac.in).
2. The qualified candidates need to be present on the notified date for counselling and admission process.
3. If the candidate fails to appear on the stipulated date for admission, it would be deemed that he/she has vacated the seat and the next candidate in the order of merit/rank shall be given the opportunity for admission.
4. If two or more candidates have secured equivalent marks/rank in the merit Index of entrance test, then the merit for admission will be determined as follows:
 - If the marks secured in the entrance are same in such cases first preference will be given to the candidate who secures higher percentage of marks in 10+2 exam.
 - If the marks secured in the class 12 or equivalent examination are also same in such cases first preference will be given to the candidate who secures higher percentage of marks at High School.

Reservation

1. The reservation shall be given as permissible under the Uttar Pradesh Government / University Rules.
2. The benefit of reservation will be permissible only to Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes (SC/ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC) and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates originally belonging to Uttar Pradesh.

Scheduled Castes/ Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes candidates of other states will be treated as general category.

3. Students belonging any category would submit a self-attested copy of their valid Caste/EWS certificate at the time of counselling.
4. The foreign candidates which are the citizen of countries other than India are exempted from appearing in entrance.
