

Event Report: World Book and Copyright Day Celebration

The GSV Central Library successfully organized a commemorative event on the occasion of World Book and Copyright Day on 23 April 2026 at library auditorium. The program aimed to highlight the significance of books, reading culture, and the evolving dimensions of copyright in the contemporary knowledge ecosystem.

The event commenced with an insightful address by *Dr. Ashish Kumar Srivastava*, University Librarian, who briefed the audience on the historic growth and relevance of copyright. He elaborated on how copyright has evolved over time and emphasized its critical role in safeguarding intellectual property while promoting creativity and knowledge dissemination. He also underscored the important role libraries play in balancing access to information with ethical use and legal compliance. *Dr. Shweta Pandey, convenor of the program* further enriched the session by presenting a detailed overview of the anatomy of copyright law and its development from the print era to the digital environment. She discussed the challenges and opportunities that digital transformation has introduced, including issues related to access, licensing, plagiarism, and fair use in academic and research contexts. Her talk provided valuable insights into how libraries are adapting to these changes while continuing to serve as custodians of knowledge.

The program witnessed enthusiastic participation from students and faculty members, particularly from the Department of Library and Information Science. The event concluded with a certificate distribution ceremony, where students of the department were awarded certificates of appreciation in recognition of their active involvement and contributions.

Overall, at university level all the departments celebrated the event and the program served as an informative and engaging platform to foster awareness about the importance of books, copyright laws, and the evolving role of libraries in the digital age.

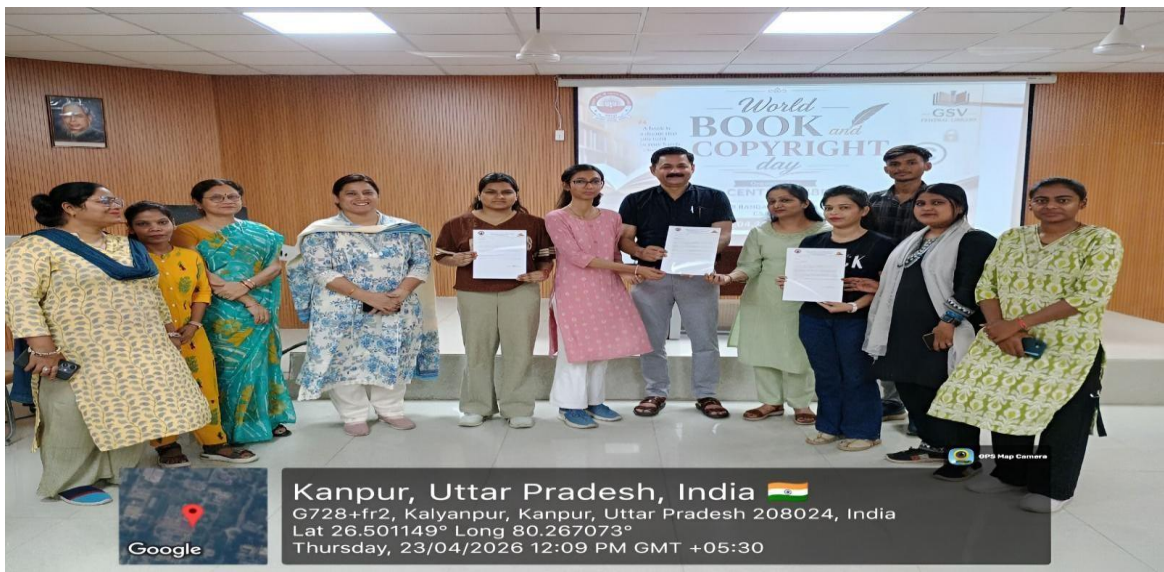
कॉपीराइट सामग्री का सही उपयोग जरूरी

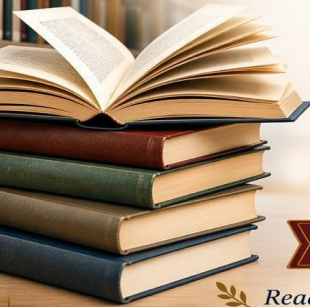
