1. That the Higher Educational Institution is eligible in all respects for offering online programmes without prior approval of the UGC, as per Regulation 3(B)(a) of University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
2. That the deponents have fully understood the clauses, terms and conditions as stipulated under University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).

b. PG Programmes (Maximum ten):

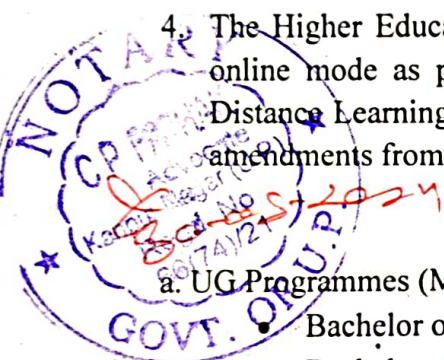
- Master of Computer Application (MCA)

5. That the Higher Educational Institution shall not offer any of the prohibited programmes i.e., programmes not permitted under clause (z) of Regulation 2 of University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020, (including its amendments from time to time). In the event, the applicable statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council permits such programme(s), the HEI shall submit the approval or recommendation of the said authority or council, for consideration of the Commission.

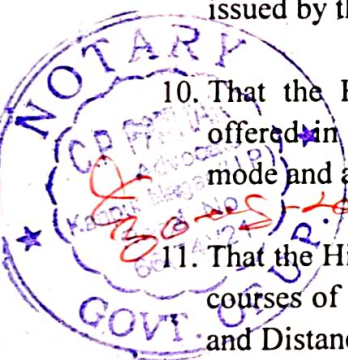
6. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures to provide all such information as asked by UGC and display the same, as per mandatory disclosure of information as stipulated under



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Regulation 9 of the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).

7. That for the programmes falling under the ambit of a statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council, the Higher Educational Institution has the approval or recommendations of the respective statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council for offering the programmes in Online mode, if applicable; and has also submitted the same to the Commission along with the application.
8. That the Higher Educational Institution offering Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Postgraduate diploma programmes under the discipline of Management, Computer Applications and Travel and Tourism is adhering to all the norms and standards stipulated by AICTE for offering these programmes in ODL/Online mode.
9. That while complying with University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time), HEI ensures the compliance to other relevant UGC Regulations and norms issued by the other statutory/regulatory bodies from time to time.
10. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures that proposed programmes are being offered in conventional mode of classroom teaching or in Open and Distance Learning mode and at least one batch has passed out from the same.
11. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures adherence to four quadrants approach in all courses of all programmes and also all other requirements as envisaged in the UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).
12. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures the readiness/availability of E- Learning Material for all years/semesters of proposed programmes shall be as per UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time) and HEI shall ensure uploading of E-Learning Material on the learning platform before the start of academic session. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures the requisite number of full time dedicated teachers exclusively for online mode and other administrative and technical staff is appointed as stipulated under Annexure-IV of UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 (including its amendments from time to time).



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15. That the Higher Educational Institution ensures to conduct proctored examinations with all the security arrangements ensuring transparency and credibility of the examinations.


