Robindranath Tagore was born on 7<sup>th</sup> May, 1861 in Calcutta. His father's name was Debendranath Tagore and his mother's name was Sarda Devi. He started his writing career at the age of 16. His one of his poem name 'Bhikshini'. He is great novelist, essayist, short story writer.

He won Nobel prize for literature in 1913 for Gitanjali (Also known as Song offerings). He is not only a good novelist but <sup>also</sup> he is <sup>great</sup> nationalist. He admired M. K. Gandhi but they did not same point of view. He always indulge himself into socio-political activity. He wrote three countries national anthem 'Jana Gana Mana' for India, 'Amar Sonar Bangla' for Bangladesh and 'Mama Nama Srilanka Mata' for Sri Lanka. He had opened a school named Shantipur.

He had died 7<sup>th</sup> August 1941 due to get into coma for two times in 1939 and 1940.

His contribution of Indian English Literature  
1) Gitanjali (1910) :- It was published in 1910. It also known as Song Offerings. He shows his spirituality and divineness in that collection.

he works with his uncle at  
drug store when he was 17  
years old and after two  
years he get his own  
licence for the pharmacy.  
He operates it and also sketch  
out some drawings whatever  
he experienced in the store &  
his customers admires his  
work. After that he went  
to Texas, to learn babysitting,  
shepherding, looping and lit  
a bit of Spanish & German from  
the migrants.



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O. Henry turns his profession from pharmacist to drafting, cooking and Banking.

Banking was one of the profession he is careless about it, so, he was fired by boss and charged with embezzlement of 2 years (1884-1886) But his father in law posted bail for him but he fled away the day before to New Orleans & then to Honduras where he met one of his robber friend. & came back to there he get back to Ardall Prison for 5 years (1889-1902) & then after he wrote a book cabbages & kings (1904), The Trimmed Lamp & other stories (1907), The Four millions (1906), The Gift of Magi,

He get died on 5 December, 1910.

The last leaf is story about the two friends Sue and Johnsy who lived together in third floor of the small flats. They both are good artist. They do artistry to earn money. As Johnsy will fall sick in November and seeing the Johnsy's condition Sue call






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the doctor to check her & then the doctor told she suffered from pneumonia and she is not willing to live. Doctor suggests to sue that ask her will I distract her. then she will get well. So she asked her why are you behaving like that & why are you gazed out of window, then Johnny slowly replied that <sup>when</sup> the last leaf will fall, then I will die. She explains her  that this is so foolish. why are looking that ivy creeper tail. She was worried about her condition so, she sold her works to get Johnny well out of illness. She explained the whole condition to Behrman (a 60-year old painter) who never make any masterpiece. Behrman suggested & told her that he would make the last leaf of the ivy creeper tail through his painting skills. & the next night there is heavy storm and darkness , lightning outside  of flat. In that



condition Behrman made a painting of leaf in wall, and the next day when Johnny woke up she said that there is still leaf & at whom that point she left the stubborn wish and doing her medicine proper. & the next day also bad news groomed that Behrman has died due to pneumonia, at that point of time Sue & Johnny both were felt guilty.

Answer 6 :-

Bacon's essay 'Of studies' is all about the benefit or merits of studies in our daily life. Sir Francis Bacon (1561-1626) was great novelist and writer. He illustrates the advantages of studies in our daily life. He states that practical of knowledge is essential to survive & stable life. He states 'Crafty man condemns studies, smart man admires them, wise man use them.' Here he states that the studies way of conceiving studying serve for gaining delight, for ornamental, for



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improving one's ability. Some books are meant to be tasted, some are there to swallow, while some are there to be chewed & digested properly. Here the poet describes that books are of different meanings and different settings, so the reader has to choose wisely, what he wants to read.

He also illustrates the one demerit of study - Studying for a long period makes a person lazy. He states that study is the only key which treats the sickness of mind. In the whole story he provoked the facts about the study. As he says that study plays a very important role in every field.

A well-knowledgeable man can only execute plans, manage their daily affairs and lead a healthy & stable life. Bacon also said that study is the key through which anything can be achieved.




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A well knowledgeable man get respect everywhere in the life. As study is the way to express ourself in a best manner. But studying only from book doesn't make you knowledgeable. The study from nature, other people make you wise man. He also states that 'Reading makes a full man, Conference leads to ready man & while writing makes an exact man'. Through this statement he tries to convey that every part of studying has its own benefits. Like reading make man eligible to get every thing well, and read makes full man whereas conferences (back and forth communication) makes man ready man and writing makes a man perfect.
