'APJ Abdul Kalam' has written an essay called 'Patriotism beyond Politics and Religion'.

Abdul Pakir Jauharabdeen 'APJ Abdul Kalam' was born on 15<sup>th</sup> October 1931 in Rameswaram, Tamil Nadu. He belonged to a very poor family.

He completed Aeronautical engineering from Madras Institute of Technology.

In this essay, he describes how a patriotism should be first before politics and religion by narrating a heart touching incident.

'Biju Patrik' one of the chief Ministers of Orissa in his days of Pilot visit to Indonesia. There, he met Indonesian President 'Sukarno'. Sukarno got blessed with a baby daughter and he was searching a name for her.

At this, Biju Patrik suggested a Sanskrit name 'Megawati' to him and without thinking about his religion, he christened her daughter 'Megawati Sukarnoputri' who later became the president and vice-president of Indonesia.

It was shocking for everyone that the president of world's largest Muslim country had gave her daughter the Hindu name of 'Megawati'. He could have denied this name due to his religion but he proved that he is patriotic man not for his country only but for



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the whole world.

APJ Abdul Kalam wanted India to develop economically, socially, science and Technology (Agricultural Science, Bio-Science) and in other fields.

He wanted India to have his nuclear strength. He wanted different cultures & religions to come together and work together.

He also told that we should always remember the glory of our past during freedom struggle, we should not forget our great fighters and other sacrifices.

He mentions that there should be collective achievements in pride, unity and combined action.

He wanted India to reach the highest position in the world. He said that politicians should work honestly by giving a shape to our nation.

He does not want diversity anywhere. He was a great patriotic man. He had great influence all over the world.

He was going to the youth of the society and encouraging them through his golden words.

He wanted everyone treated equally. In his whole life, he worked & served for India as a scientist and president as well.

He was the "11<sup>th</sup> president" of our country. He gives examples of "A. R. Rahman" who being a muslim sings Vande Mataram.

He died on 7<sup>th</sup> August, 1943 at 80 years.

In his fiction when Chandu 'A Barber belonged to low class' wore a dress-up of high caste man, he ~~is~~ <sup>was</sup> abused by orthodox people including landlords, ~~subcastes~~ <sup>castes</sup> and priests. He was told to change the get up and get lost. He was insulted from everywhere.

No one ~~was~~ was talking to him politely. He was made isolated everywhere.

He had no mistake. He had just simply got an attire of a Dentist of Kalan Khan who lived in nearby Town. Except khadi shorts, black waist coat and round felt cap, he wore white Turban, white rubber coat and carried a leather bag due to which he was abused and he had to hear harsh words of orthodox edicts.

In this fiction, we come to know that high caste people always show their strength and superiority and they insult and humiliate lower - people.

This is a Harsh Truth of reality.

At the end Chandu protested against them by refusing to do their works of head cutting and shaving and by learning riding a Japanese Cycle he went to Town and opened his own shop named

'Rajkot ~~Barbers~~ District Barber Brothers Hairdressing and Shaving Salon'.
