INTEGRATED LEARNING THROUGH G.S.V. CENTRAL LIBRARY

Relentless determination, planning and investment to unite traditional library facilities with evolving electronic resources have resulted in the excellent and widely praised Ganesh Shanker Vidyarthi Central Library and E-learning environment at Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur.

The Central Library provides resource discovery and delivery information analysis and processing, information communication and presentation all through the seamless integration of the physical and electronic environment. This is the key to the success of the University learning resources strategy. The library timings have been extended and the facilities can be availed by the students between 8.00 A.M. to 9.00 P.M. and even on Sundays.

The library is well stocked with a variety of books on management, engineering and technology, humanities and social sciences, economics, commerce and basic sciences, Hindi and English. A wide range of periodicals, journals and magazines are subscribed in the library. The library has an inventory of more than 100000 books and access licences to as many as 5000 electronic journals.

Computerisation and networking of the central library has been completed. A subnet has been developed. Internet connectivity has been extended to the library.

For automation a software, SOUL has been purchased and put to use. All library resources including OPAC have been put on the web for remote access.





AUDITORIUM

The University has a high-tech auditorium with a seating capacity of over 1500. Its ground breaking and usual design provides a state-of-the-art venture for international conferencing. As a beautiful performance space, it gives new impetus to the expansion of the CSJMU's cultural and arts programs and contributes to the establishment of the university as one of the main cultural centres in the area.

FACULTY RESIDENCES

The residential facilities for faculty members are provided in the university campus. There are six professor's type V residences. besides two double and triple storied types IV residences to accommodate 26 faculty members with 24 hour electricity facilities, water facilities and green and serene campus.

RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES FOR NON-TEACHING STAFF

Residential facilities for non-teaching staff have been provided in the university campus. A number of type I,II,III,IV and V houses have been constructed for this purpose which are being used by non-teaching staff of the university.



HEALTH CENTRE

The Institute of Health Sciences has been established in the state of art building in the university campus. This Institute operates health centre. The nature of facilities available in the health centre are OPD facilities, beds available for inpatients, pathological investigations, ECG, minor OT, services of doctors are available with specialization in medicine, orthopaedics, obstetrics and gynae, paediatrics, general surgery, ophthalmology, clinical psychology, psychiatry, ENT and dental.

HOSTEL FACILITIES

The university provides residential accommodation for boys as well as girls in the campus. The homely atmosphere at university is acclaimed as a unique feature of the university academic programmes. This provides for greater interaction among the students of different cultural backgrounds and enhances the scope of learning at the university.

There are twoboys hostel and four Girls hostels in the university campus. The facilities provided in the hostel are mess, reading room, common room, badminton and basketball play grounds, indoor games facilities etc.

- The infrastructural facilities are regularly upgraded. A Legal Aid Clinic in the Institute of Legal Studies was also inaugurated by Honourable Chancellor and Governor, Uttar Pradesh, Shri Ram Naik Ji on 05-10-2017. The swimming pool 'Funstroke' is at par with International standards. Many new Projects like Shrimati Raj Kumari Devi Women Transit Hostel, Deendayal Upadhyay Auditorium, centralized Girls' Common Room, record room etc. are underway. A new 166 ft. flagpost has been constructed in the premises of University Administrative Building.

(Hon.), PG Diploma in Guidance and Counselling, B.Sc. (Yoga), BHMCT (4 year) have started running in the campus.
- The University carries out the transmission of VidyavaniProgramme on every Saturday between 7.00 and 7.30 P.M. on Vividh Bharati FM 103.7 MHz to provide access to subject related knowledge by experts to students in remote areas through mass media.
- The Research is promoted in the University through PhD Program, by supporting faculty members for research publications and conferences and through Minor Projects supported by the University and Other sponsored projects supported by different agencies like DST, UGC, AICTE, ICSSR etc.

- University publishes its biannual newsletter. This newsletter includes all the academic and extracurricular activities undertaken by the faculty and the students.
- The University has a system to support and mentor its students through the University Placement Cell and the Dean Students' Welfare Office.
- Online Grievance Portal of the University facilitates the students to lodge their grievance online and track its progress.

- To provide various online services to its students in affiliated colleges and University campus, the initiative to generate Web Registration Number (WRN) by the students at the time of admission has helped in digitally empowering the University.


