The purpose of this project was to simplify the intricate web of affiliated colleges to the University by allowing the administration to re monitor in real-time the exact location of the college, thus, enabling better coordination in conducting examinations, developing new colleges and withholding examination centre malpractices in all of 635 affiliated colleges of CSJMU. The Mapping Project was executed by Associate Professor Dr Satish Chandra, Assistant Professor Dr Kashif Imdad and their team under the leadership of Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak.

While addressing the audience at the event Governor/Chancellor Smt. Anadiben Patel Praised the effort of Anganwadi workers in the consistent and persistent aide to children and mothers in the rural area. She also urged the youth to develop a mindset with every individual to the upliftment of the most backward class of the society. Furthermore, she also said that Anganwadi workers can help eradicate malnutrition and minimize the infant mortality rate in the rural areas and for that, they need to update their work practice in accordance with the 21st century and in that universities can help in that. The university will use this portal in determining the examination centres, in granting recognition to the college, in conducting the examinations fairly.

Cabinet Minister Industrial Development Mr. Satish Mahana in his address said the glory of Kanpur is known across the globe because of its industries and thanked all the Industrialists for their support in the social welfare program.
