CSJMU Organizes a Symposium (Vichar Gosthi) to commemorate Mahaparinirvana Diwas: the 65th Death Anniversary of Dr B.R. Ambedkar.

The School of Humanities and Department of Education organized a symposium to discuss the ideology of the father of the Indian Constitution Dr. B. R. Ambedkar. The symposium was conducted under the chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak. The other experts present at the Dice were Prof. Munish Kumar, Prof. Sudhir Kumar Awasthi and Registrar Dr. Anil Yadav.

Addressing the Symposium Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak said, that merely garlanding the photos and remembering these prominent personalities of Indian civilization for a day is not enough. He also suggested the opening of research courses to study the life of great Indian personalities while assuring all financial aid to those doing the research.

Prof. Munish Kumar HoD, Department of Education put an elaborate thought about the ideologies and morals of the Baharat Ratna Dr. B.R. Ambedkar and called him a man with centuries ahead vision. He also referred to instances where Ambedkar's philosophies of Equalities failed to establish in India. Besides this, he called him the leader of the underprivileged and women. Furthermore, he mentioned Dr.B.R. Ambekar's view on National saying that he did not believe in a nation that was just a piece of land for him it was a feeling of Unity and Oneness among its inhabitants. Lastly, he talked about Articles 45 and 46 of the directive principles of the States which focus on the enrollment of children below 14 years of age till 1960. If India would have accomplished that, we would have been a superpower in the world.

Dean of Students welfare Prof. Sudhir Kumar Awasthi said in his address explained the Buddhist meaning of Parinirvana as the cessation of desires, Babasaheb had adopted Buddhism before his death, hence his death anniversary is celebrated as Parinirvana Day. Ambedkar made a lot of efforts to remove social evils. He said that Ambedkar was a genius the talents of Dr B.R. Ambedkar remained unrecognised for a long time. His ideas are still relevant in life today. We must follow his ideas.

While conducting the program, Dr. Sandeep Singh, Head of Department of Social Work, introduced the life of Baba Bhimrao Ambedkar and told about his work and thoughts. He told that Ambedkar had an important contribution to the all-around development of India.
