Our primary goal during the redesign process was to create a more valuable, student-centric and responsive website across all platforms and devices. Specifically, we dedicated the 'Student Service Portal' with a focus on making it easier for our students to learn and locate valuable information in educational domain like online lectures, Digital library, institutional updates and grievances, etc. We have also tried to make it easier for students to resolve administrative queries like Degree Certificate, Migration certificate, Marksheet certificate, Provisional certificate etc. through this portal.

This Resourceful initiative was inaugurated by the Hon'ble Dy. Chief Minister Dr. Dinesh Sharma. Upon which, he said that the efforts of the CSJMU Administration under Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak has witnessed phenomenal change, both in terms of education, and administration in the last 6 months of his tenure. Furthermore, he was pleased by the efforts CSJM University has put into the digitalization of the education system. he also added that this education will be beneficial in case the Third way of coronavirus happens.
