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CSJMU organises One day training programme for “Newly Elected Women Pradhan of Panchayati Raj System”.

The Social Works Department of CSJM University organised a One-day Training Programme for “ Newly elected Women Pradhan of Panchayati Raj System”. The purpose of this training event was the upliftment of women in the Legislative system.

The special guest this one-day training programme was Prof. Anshu Yadav. The event was then conducted by the Head of Department (MSW) Dr. Sandeep K. Singh, trainer from National Youth Foundation, Lucknow Mr Aminesh Rai and Mr Samdesh Rai and 70 ‘Women Gram Pradhans’ from Kalyanpur, Chaubepur, and Bidunu block of Kanpur District.

The training session began with the lighting of the lamp by the Prof. Anshu Yadav and other guests as a symbolisation for enlightenment through this training session.

The special Guest of this event made a speech emphasising on the need of empowering women through skill development. She also suggested the ‘Women Prahans’ to work self-lessly towards the betterment of each individual of their village in terms of health, education, and social and financial development. She also told about the University intentions of supporting the rural livelihood by adopting villages and transforming them into ‘Adarsh Village’. She further added the importance of developing online technology skills which could allow them to fetch the right value for their produce in the market. Furthermore, She assured full cooperation of all departments of CSJMU to the Gram Pradhans in their development efforts and sought the reciprocation from the ‘Gram pradhans’ as well.

The HoD of MSW, Dr. Sandeep K Singh headed this training session emphasising over women empowerment for the development of villages of India. He also appreciated the vision of Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak about taking up the responsibility of the society. He also asked the Women Pradhan to lead the way in the development of Society. And also trained the women representative in leadership skills, technical skills and ways to manage their electoral more proficiently by enhancing management skills, financial skills, and online skills and assured the Gram Pradhan full support of the MSW Department, National Service Scheme (NSS) and NCC in their developments initiatives.

Mr. Animesh Rai from the National youth Foundation, Mr Samdesh Rai trained the Women Pradhan about the Responsibilities of Pradhans and ways to manage the villages by appropriately organizing the Bank accounts, Audit report of the previous years, and Estimation report for the current year plans and main works of a Pradhan like Primary health facility, Sanitary scheme, Mid-day Meal, public distribution System, etc. They also made the representative aware about RTI and various government Websites like <https://egramswaraj.in>, <https://Panchyattiraj.up.nic.in>, <https://nirmalgrampuraskar.in>, where the representative can find all information regarding State and National level Scheme for Village Panchayat. Throughout the exercise, all the trainers sought constant feedbacks and promptly resolved the queries of representatives of the villages.

The training session comprised of 4 segments each focusing on Awareness, Responsibilities, Leadership and Work Model for village developments and was concluded after the feedback session where students of MSW helped the women Pradhans to identify the issues of their village and plans a solution for the resolution of these issues. The faculties of MSW distributed Participation Certificate to all Women Pradhans who attended this session. The training session was also attended by Asst Prof. Mr. Satendra Singh Chauhan, Dr. Uravasi, Dr. Rashmi Dubey, Dr Anita Awasthi, and other faculties of the MSW department.
