78 new professional courses to begin in CSJMU

In the meeting of Academic Council meeting held at Chhatrapati Shahuji Maharaj University today, Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak decided to start 78 professional courses. In which MA (Digital Journalism), Diploma in Electrical Engineering and Diploma in Chemical Engineering etc. courses are prominent. Apart from this, Deendayal Shodh Kendra will commence two new courses PG Diploma (Deendayal Vichar), MA in Astrology aimed at providing education of astrology and rituals. In the meeting, it was decided to implement the National Education Policy-2020 proposed by the Uttar Pradesh government at the postgraduate level from the next academic session. A new ordinance was passed to give autonomy to various schools operating on the campus. From the coming session, the study of B.Sc Agriculture and B.Sc Horticulture will be started on the university campus.

Keeping in view the immense employment opportunities in the health sector, it was agreed in the meeting to sign an MoU between GSVM College and the School of Health Sciences. Under Yagya Foundation, an Indian-origin entrepreneur working in the US will provide scholarships to 30 undergraduate and postgraduate students and 5 internships in computer science. Among other important decisions in the meeting of the Academic Council, three awards will be given by the Bank of Baroda for Sports, Academic and All-rounder UG and PG level performance. Along with this, consent was also given by the School of Legal Studies to run Legal Aid Clinics in 10 villages. The Department of Hotel Management in the University campus was given the recognition of a separate school. Till now this department was running under the School of Engineering and Technology. A resolution was passed to start a new musical band Vani on the university campus. Academic audit of various courses running in the university was been conducted by IQAC for a long time, the report of which was approved unanimously in the meeting of the Academic Council today.

In the meeting of the Academic Council, Pro Vice-Chancellor Prof. Sudhir Kumar Awasthi, Registrar Dr. Anil Kumar Yadav, Prof. Sanjay Swarnkar, CDC Director Dr. R.K. Dwivedi, Finance Officer PS Chaudhary and Director and Heads from various schools and departments were present.
