All India Inter University Judo Competition in CSJMU from today

The All-India Inter-University Judo Competition will start on Tuesday, March 22 at Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, Kanpur. The women's judo competition will be played from 22 to 24 March and the men's judo competition will be played from 25 to 27 March. 500 female and 600 male participants from about 183 universities across the country will participate in this competition. The competition was presided over by the Vice-Chancellor Prof. Vinay Kumar Pathak and Vice-Chancellor Prof. D.R. Singh, Chandra Shekhar Azad University of Agriculture and Technology, Kanpur will inaugurate the competition.

Different events will be held in seven categories for women: 78kg, 78 kg, 70 kg, 63 kg, 57 kg, 52 kg, 48 kg. For men, different events will be held in seven categories: 100 kg, 100 kg, 90 kg, 81 kg, 73 kg, 66 kg, 60 kg.

The Judo competition starting from 22nd March will be organized in the multipurpose hall located in the university campus, in which the participants of universities from many states like Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Delhi, Maharashtra, Gujarat, Rajasthan, Chhattisgarh, etc. are participating. This competition will be convened with strict compliance of Covid-19 rules, it is mandatory for the participants/coach/manager to have both doses of vaccination, if the participant/coach/manager is not vaccinated, then their RT-PCR report will need to be submitted to officials.

Organizing Secretary Dr. R.P. Singh informed that various committees have been formed for the competition, such as housing committee, registration committee, fooding committee etc. All these committees have been made to organize the work related to the competition in a convenient manner. Three buses have been arranged to bring the participants from the station to the university so that the participants do not face any kind of problem. Along with this, arrangements for accommodation and food for the participants have also been made within the university campus..
