

DECLARATION OF MUTUAL COOPERATION BETWEEN

Chhatrapati Shahu Ji Maharaj University, formerly known as Kanpur University, is a public state university located in Kanpur, Uttar Pradesh. The University was established in 1966, has been on the map of higher education for more than five decades. CSJMU is recognised by UGC and accredited by NAAC. It is administered under the state legislature of the Government of Uttar Pradesh. It has over 900 affiliated colleges in 11 districts. The over 260-acre campus of CSJMU, Kanpur is pretty impressive in its architectural design, with a botanical garden, a photographic, an eye-popping auditorium and impressive quarters for both, faculty and visiting national and international guests and eminent speakers. The University's academic field covers all the possible streams one can think of. The undergraduate and post-graduate programmes are offered in Department of Life Sciences and Biotechnology, Department of Pharmaceutical Sciences, School of Health Sciences, School of Basic Sciences, School of Management and Information Sciences, School of Hotel Management, School of Creative and Performing Arts, Education, and English. For catering the needs of young aspirants, University also has a School of Engineering and Technology, Languages, Legal Studies, Teacher Education, and Arts, Humanities and Social Sciences. The University seeks to contribute to student an education through curriculum design, the development of new courses and the application of a forward looking and innovative teaching methodology.

CSJMU envisaged for excellence in transformative education and leadership in higher education to encourage students for competitive learning environment, and to provide incubation facility to student start-ups. To achieve the same all courses are designed to keep the current and emerging industrial as well as societal human resource requirements.

Versatile and innovative teaching methodologies are adopted to achieve the same. The faculty receives encouragement to pursue research work alongside their teaching role. In fact, CSJMU has a special College Development Council which ensures quality facilities to its affiliated colleges to obtain assistance from the University Grants Commission (U.G.C.) for developmental activities and research projects for faculty.

The "Society for Environmental Sustainability" is registered under the Society Registration Act XXVI, 1860 in the state of Uttar Pradesh. The vision of the Society is 'Conservation of environment, ecosystems and natural resources using biological approaches'. The Society works on the mission of 'Promoting scientific knowledge and awareness for sustaining the environment and natural resources by eco-friendly means for sustenance of our planet and to provide better living habitats/ conditions for future generations'. The aims and objectives of the Society are available on http://ses-india.org.

CSJM University and Society for Environmental Sustainability, enter into the following terms of the agreement to promote education and research:

- Exchange of information for research and involvement in joint projects under the participation of faculty, scientists, researchers, staff, and students from both sides.
- Application of joint projects related to the aims and objectives of both the parties to funding agencies at National and International levels.
- 3. Provide training and visits by members and staff.
- Holding and organizing joint workshops, symposia, seminars, and conferences in areas of mutual academic, research and innovation interests.
- 5. Faculty development programs and joint research publications.
- 6. Curriculum design
- 7. Student development program like industrial problems and possible solutions.
- 8. The association will remain in force for an initial period of five years and can be pursued based on mutual consent.

General terms of the agreement:

- 1. The agreement will come into effect on the date of signing.
- 2. Amendments and additions may be made to the agreement subject to the consent of the parties.

- Financial obligations regarding programs and exchanges will be discussed and agreed upon separately by the parties.
- 4. The modalities, funding and financial arrangements of any activity arising from this agreement will be jointly agreed upon in writing by both parties.
- Research papers, patents or any other copyright material coming out of joint projects will be shared equally or as decided by both the parties, looking at the contribution of each party.
- 6. Either party may terminate this agreement at any time upon 60 days prior written notice to the other party. Both parties shall have the right to terminate this agreement at any time in the event of a material breach by the other party of its obligation under this agreement. Such termination will become effective in 60 days after giving such notice unless the other party shall have corrected the breach prior thereto. Termination of the agreement for whatever reason shall not affect the rights and obligations of the parties existing at the date of termination.
- 7. The management of the organizations will amicably resolve any dispute arising during the execution of the MOU jointly. However, in case they fail to agree it will be referred to as a mutually acceptable arbitrator.
- 8. The agreement shall be executed in two compartments, each of which shall be deemed an original but all of this together shall constitute the same instrument.
- 9. Any amendment to this agreement shall be in writing and signed by both parties.
- 10. All notices to be given in connection with this agreement shall be effective upon receipt, shall be made in writing.
- 11. Neither of the parties shall be held responsible for any delay or failure in performance hereunder caused by fire, strikes of third party's personal, embargoes, requirements imposed by Governmental, civil and military authorities, acts of God or by the public enemy or other similar causes beyond such party's reasonable control without fault or negligence.
- 12. If any dispute arises it will be amicably solved by a joint committee consisting of equal number of members nominated from both sides.
- 13. Each institution shall designate liaison officers for this agreement. The liaison officers will be responsible for coordinating the specific aspects of the cooperation.

Notification of any change in liaison officers may be made in writing. Amendments of the agreement are not necessary in this case.

14. Duration of the agreement: this agreement will come into effect with the appropriate signatures of each organization. It will remain in force for five (5) years with the understanding that it may be terminated by the appropriate authorities of either organization giving six months written notice to the other organization. The agreement is renewable and it may be amended by mutual written consent. The agreement is written and signed in two identical copies in English having equal force.
