GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR COURSEWORK AND EXAMINATIONS 2022-23

1. Each paper will carry 100 marks: 70 marks for theory paper (MCQ based) and 30 for internal assessment. The internal assessment in RM (Paper I), paper II and Paper III will be based on two Mid Term examinations of 10 marks each (objective/Quiz) and one short report and its power point presentation of 30 marks.
2. The marks for short report and presentation would be evaluated for attendance 5 marks (5 for $\geq 75\%$; 3 for 60-75%); writing, subject content and presentation for 12.5 marks and elaboration, usage and justification of research component used in solving subject specific problem/analysis for 12.5 marks.
3. The marks of presentation would be equally divided in all three papers, RM (paper I), paper II and paper III. For example., if student gets 24/30; 8 marks would be given for all three papers.
4. Students would be required to submit Review/Project/Field work/Practical work in soft copy and hard copy in the following headings:
 - ✚ Introduction: Clearly define the issue and general limitations
 - ✚ Objectives: Precise two-three objectives which can help solve the existing limitations
 - ✚ National and International Status: Existing data on the problem at national and international level with references.
 - ✚ Methodology: Clear and defined methodology with emphasis of the tools and techniques learned in research methodology to address the subject specific problem.
 - ✚ Expected Outcome: Well, defined possible outcomes with statistical tools of research methodology.
 - ✚ Societal justification and future prospects: Justify the selection of your chosen problem with respect to the benefits to the society and what are the future prospects of the study.

In this student should be beware about primary, secondary and tertiary sources. He/she should be well versed with authentic and non-authentic sources and essential plagiarism check should be performed.

The references should be cited in uniform pattern

The student should follow standard pattern of referencing

5. The internal assessment in all three papers, paper I, paper II and paper III will be based on two Mid-term examinations and report writing and seminar presentation with report of about 5000 words on any subject of the student's choice dealing with the field of research.
 6. The candidate will have to obtain at least 50% marks in theory as well as internal assessment in order to qualify the course.
 7. 75% attendance will be compulsory in theory/practical classes.
 8. The marks distribution of internal assessment (30 marks) will be: 10 marks for first mid sem. Test, 10 marks for second mid-term test and 30 marks for report, presentation and attendance as mentioned above.
