The nomenclature of semesters under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) will be as follows,

- (a) **Odd Semester:** (I and III Semester (for the four-semester program)/ (I, III and V Semester (for the six-semester program), and
(b) **Even Semester:** (II and IV Semester (for the four-semester program)/ (II, IV and VI Semester (for the six-semester program),

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NOTE:

- (i) For each minor/ major credit course (both for theory and practical) minimum passing percentage will be 33% for UG and PG and student must secure at least 33 % marks in University External Examination i.e. 25 marks out of 75 marks.
- (ii) For Co-curricular courses and project work (UG and PG), the minimum passing percentage will be 40% in end semester examination.
- (iii) Similarly, in the skill development /vocational courses, the minimum passing percentage will be 40% in internal plus external examination.
- (iv) There will be no provision for Grace marks.
- (v) Maximum duration of the UG program (3 years/6 semesters) can be extended up to 6 years
- (vi) Maximum duration of the UG program (4 years/ 8 semesters) can be extended up to 8 years.
- (vii) Maximum duration of the PG program (2 years/4 semesters) will be up to 4 years.
- (viii) Those student who have not appeared in 1st and 2nd semester examination (complete absentee in external Exam) would be considered as a year gap and will have to take a fresh admission in first semester.
- (ix) Counting semesters: University allotted paper code under NEP2020 by considering first year PG as 7th and 8th semester and second year PG as a 9th and 10th semester. In this ordinance to keep the thing simple and clear counting of semesters in PG starts from 1st which is equal to 7th semester for allotting paper code and other purposes.
- (x) Promotion rules for courses/programme not covered under NEP2020 shall be governed by their respective ordinance.
