## Guidelines for Admission to B. Tech Program 2024-25

- All information regarding B. Tech admissions and Schedule for the Registration/Counselling process will be available on www.csjimu.ac.in
- Candidates are advised to read the guidelines for admission carefully, check their eligibility as per the applicable reservation category etc before filling and submitting the Online Registration Form.
- Candidates are advised to fill in Choice of Branch as per his/her eligibility and which they prefer to join. Once the Choice filling activity is over for all registered candidates as per specified schedule, an Automated Seat Allotment Process will be executed based on merit and seat will be allotted to the candidate as per the Choices/Preferences submitted by the Candidate.
- The following factors will be considered before allocating the highest possible seat according to candidates' choices:
- Category and subcategory of the candidate - [GEN, OBC-NCL, SC, etc.]
- All India Rank (AIR) of the candidate in JEE Mains Rank List and according to the priority order of Choice of Branch filled by the candidates.
- Availability of seats under different seat categories/seat quotas for which the candidate is eligible.
- Subsequently, the same Seat Allotment result will be published online (candidates can view their allotment using their login credentials).
- Seat Acceptance Fee for FREEZE/FLOAT candidates and Balance Fee for students opting for FREEZE option can be paid through Net Banking/Credit/Debit Card or e-challan.


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- Reservation of seats will be as follows:

1. Vertical Reservation

| Category | Percentage of reservation |

| (b) Schedules castes of UP | $21 \%$ |
| (c) Schedules tribes of UP | $02 \%$ |

2. Horizontal Reservation

A candidate can be given only one type of reservation FF/AF/PH. However, Girl candidates can claim FF/AF/PH reservation along with GL.

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3. EWS Reservation

Candidates who wish to avail the benefit of EWS quota must not be covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes. They must upload Certificate No. 10 issued by the Government Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar to claim the benefit of this reservation.

- Request for change of category/sub-category filled in Online Registration Form will not be entertained under any circumstance.
- Category/Sub-category certificates must be uploaded during the online application process through the Online Registration Form in the format provided and uploaded on the website. Failing to do this would mean that the candidate will not be considered for the Category/Sub-category claimed.
- Seat Conversion Rule in Second Round of counselling
a) Allotment of seats to all registered candidates without any seat conversion.
b) Conversion of sub-category seats into respective parent category seats i.e.,

OPGL/OPFF/OPPH/OPAF $\rightarrow$ OP
SCGL/SCFF/SCPH/SCAF $\rightarrow$ SC
STGL/STFF/STPH/STAF $\rightarrow$ ST
BCGL/BCFF/BCPH/BCAF $\rightarrow$ BC
c) After doing all types of conversions (as above), if there are any vacant seats available in sub-categories, then conversion rule will be followed again, and this process will be followed until the seats in sub-categories become ' 0 '.
d) There is no conversion of SC, ST, BC and EWS seats in this round.

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- Sear Conversion Rule in Third Round of counselling
a) Allotment of seats to all registered candidates without any seat conversion of vertical reservation.
b) Conversion of ST seats into SC and then re-allotment
c) After doing the all types of conversions (as above), if there are any vacant seats available in ST then conversion rule will be followed again and this process will be followed until the seats in ST become ' 0 '.
d) Then conversion of SC and BC seats into Open category seats i.e.

and then re-allotment will be done.
e) After doing all types of conversions (as above said), If there are any vacant seats available in ST, SC and $B C$ then conversion rule will be followed again, and this process will be followed until the seats in SC \& BC become ' 0 '
f) Finally, all vacant seats will be available only in the Open and EWS category.

- The allotted seat will go into AUTO FREEZE mode after the Third Round of counselling.
- Accepting admission to UIET, CSJM University implies that the candidate and his/her parents accept all the terms and conditions laid down by CSJM University.
- If any document or declaration submitted by the candidate is found to be false at any stage of the admission process, his/her admission will be cancelled.
