- Title of the Paper
- Name of the author(s)
- E-mail address
- Postal address and Contact Number
- Co-authorship is allowed. (Maximum two authors)

- All the Abstracts shall be submitted via the Google Forms shared below (i.e., Registration Link). Further, All Abstract submissions are required to be mailed to abvslsnationalseminar@gmail.com as well, before the last date of Abstract Submission.
