## Roles and Responsibilities:

## 4. Creative Research and Professional Practice:

- > Engage in professional creative practices in theatre or film, contributing to the field through research, publications, or artistic works.
- > Pursue opportunities for grants and external funding to support creative projects and research.

#### 5. Student Engagement and Recruitment:

- > Actively participate in student recruitment efforts, including auditions, portfolio reviews, and outreach events.
- > Advise students on academic and career pathways, supporting their transition into professional roles or graduate studies.

#### 6. Community and Industry Engagement:

- > Foster partnerships with industry professionals and community organizations to create internship opportunities and collaborative projects.
- > Organize public events, screenings, and workshops that connect the university's program to the wider community.

## Prerequisites:

> Distinguished experts who have made remarkable contributions in the field of theatre and cinema with a proven expertise in their specific profession or role with at least 15 years of experience.

A demonstrated record of creative work in theatre, film, or digital media (e.g., films produced, plays directed, major acting roles, technical design projects), which may

include awards, screenings, or professional credits.

Experience in designing, revising, or implementing courses or workshops in theatre, cinema, or related disciplines, especially those that reflect emerging trends and technologies

> A strong network of industry connections and a willingness to establish partnerships that benefit students through internships, guest lectures, or collaborative projects with theatres, studios, or film production companies.

## **General Conditions:**

> The engagement of Professor of Practice will be for a fixed term.

> The engagement of Professor of Practice will be exclusive of the sanctioned posts of a university/college. It will not affect the number of sanctioned posts and the recruitment of regular faculty members.

> Professor of Practice is not open for those in teaching profession- serving or retired.
