Current Interventions

-  Ban the use of single-use plastics in canteens, hostels, shopping complex etc. in the University premises.
-  To conduct awareness sessions, training programmes and workshops on the harmful impacts of single use plastics.
-  Adopted provisions to provide steel cups and plates for serving food on the occasions of programs organized by different clubs and associations.
-  A campaign to convert into 'plastic-free villages' through promoting awareness and encouraging shift to alternative products is initiated.

Policy/Guidelines of the Institute

-  Inclusion of courses relevant to ocean and marine conservation topics.
-  Participation in global forums and support campaigns related to ocean health and marine life protection.
-  Vocational courses to sensitize the young generation about the importance of these ecosystems as well as train them to take up such activities

Future Plans

-  Increase partnerships with coastal organizations to engage in marine conservation efforts.
-  Initiate research projects focused on sustainable use of marine resources.
-  River cleaning activities with local NGOs
