The nomenclature of semesters under Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) will be as follows,

- (a) **Odd Semester:** (I and III Semester (for the four-semester program)/ (I, III and V Semester (for the six-semester program), and
- (b) **Even Semester:** (II and IV Semester (for the four-semester program)/ (II, IV and VI Semester (for the six-semester program),

**NOTE:**

- (i) For each minor/ major credit course (both for theory and practical) minimum passing percentage will be **33% for UG and PG and student must secure at least 33 % marks in University External Examination i.e. 25 marks out of 75 marks.**
- (ii) For Co-curricular courses and project work (UG and PG), the minimum passing percentage will be **40% in end semester examination.**
- (iii) Similarly, in the skill development /vocational courses, the minimum passing percentage will be **40% in internal plus external examination.**
- (iv) There will be no provision for Grace marks.
- (v) Maximum duration of the UG program (3 years/6 semesters) can be extended up to 6 years
- (vi) Maximum duration of the UG program (4 years/ 8 semesters) can be extended up to 8 years.
- (vii) Maximum duration of the PG program (2 years/4 semesters) will be up to 4 years.
- (viii) Those student who have not appeared in 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> semester examination (complete absentee in external Exam) would be considered as a year gap and will have to take a fresh admission in first semester.
- (ix) Counting semesters: University allotted paper code under NEP2020 by considering first year PG as 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> semester and second year PG as a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> semester. In this ordinance to keep the thing simple and clear counting of semesters in PG starts from 1<sup>st</sup> which is equal to 7<sup>th</sup> semester for allotting paper code and other purposes.
- (x) Promotion rules for courses/programme not covered under NEP2020 shall be governed by their respective ordinance.

### **Calculation of CGPA**

---

#### **(a) Calculation of SGPA and CGPA**

SGPA and CGPA shall be calculated according to the following formulae:

**For the  $j^{\text{th}}$  Semester:**

$$SGPA(S_j) = \frac{\sum(C_i \times G_i)}{\sum C_i}$$

where

- $C_i$  = Number of credits of the  $i^{\text{th}}$  course in the  $j^{\text{th}}$  semester
- $G_i$  = Grade point obtained by the student in the  $i^{\text{th}}$  course in the  $j^{\text{th}}$  semester

---

#### **CGPA Calculation:**

$$CGPA(S_j) = \frac{\sum(C_j \times S_j)}{\sum C_j}$$

where

- $S_j$  = SGPA of the  $j^{\text{th}}$  semester
- $C_j$  = Total number of credits in the  $j^{\text{th}}$  semester

#### **(b) Conversion of CGPA into Percentage**

CGPA shall be converted into percentage marks using the following formula:

$$\text{Equivalent Percentage} = \text{CGPA} \times 9.5$$

**(c) Award of Division**

The division shall be awarded to students according to the following table:

<b>Division</b>	<b>CGPA Range</b>
First Division	CGPA 6.50 or above
Second Division	CGPA 5.00 or above and less than 6.50
Third Division	CGPA 4.00 or above and less than 5.00
