About the Conference:

This conference will serve as an academic forum for reviewing the ideas, methodologies, and impacts of these two books on linguistics, education, translation, and digital innovation. Participants will critically evaluate the proposed framework of **“Bhartiya Bhasha Parivar & Artificial Intelligence: Challenges & Possibilities in the 21st Century”** through various sessions, panel discussions, and interactive reviews. They will also be able to assess how relevant this framework is to the decolonization of linguistic thought, the promotion of mother-tongue-based education, and the strengthening of India’s multilingual unity. Moreover, it will be established that the relationship between Indian language families and artificial intelligence is not merely a technological dialogue, but also a determinant of the social, cultural, and educational future. The twenty-first century offers Indian languages an opportunity to gain a new global identity, provided that sustained and scientifically grounded efforts are made to technologically empower these languages.

Bharatiya Bhasha Samiti :

This committee was constituted by the Ministry of Education (Government of India) in the year 2021. Its primary objective is to implement on the ground the provisions related to Indian languages as outlined in the National Education Policy–2020, and to promote and strengthen them. The committee is chaired by the renowned linguist Shri Chamu Krishna Shastry.


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
