NOTIFICATION

In accordance with the provisions of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, and the Undergraduate Curriculum Framework (UGCF)-2022, the modalities for implementation of the **Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit (ME-ME) Scheme in the Undergraduate and Postgraduate Programmes of CSJM University** are hereby notified. This notification is issued for information and compliance by students desirous of availing the facilities provided under the said scheme.

- (1) The Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit (ME-ME) options as outlined in the National Credit Framework (NCrF) under NEP 2020 shall be implemented for all programmes that have adopted NEP 2020.
- (2) For programmes governed by statutory or regulatory bodies such as AICTE, PCI, BCI, NCTE, ICMR, etc., the exit policies shall strictly follow the provisions and guidelines of the respective regulatory authorities.
- (3) The following exit options are based on the relevant provisions of the National Credit Framework (Section 3.4.3 – Establishing Multiple Entry and Multiple Exit Pathways) and the Government of Uttar Pradesh Order No. 301/Sattar-3-2021-16(26)/2011:

A. Undergraduate Programmes (Three- or Four-Year Duration)

- **Undergraduate Certificate [Level 4.5]** – Awarded after successful completion of **one year** of study and all prescribed credits of the First Year
- **Undergraduate Diploma [Level 5]** – Awarded after successful completion of **two years** of study and all prescribed credits of the First and Second Years.
- **Bachelor's Degree [Level 5.5]** – Awarded after successful completion of **three years** of study and all prescribed credits of the First, Second, and Third Years.
- **Bachelor's Degree with Honours/Honours with Research/Apprenticeship Embedded UG Degree [Level 6]** – Awarded after successful completion of **four years** of study and all required credits of the four-year undergraduate programme.
- **Three-year Bachelor's Honours programme/3-year Single subject programmes [Level 5.5]** - Students admitted to the 3-year Honours programs shall exit with a Bachelor's degree with Hons in a specific subject upon successful completion of the prescribed credits of all the three years. The same shall apply to three-year single subject programmes such as BCA, BBA etc.

B. Master's Programmes (Two-Year Duration)

- **Postgraduate Diploma [Level 6]** – Awarded after successful completion of **one year** of study and all prescribed credits of the First Year of the Master's programme.
- **Master's Degree [Level 6.5]** – Awarded after successful completion of **two years** of study and all prescribed credits of both years following a three-year Bachelor's degree.
- **Master's Degree [Level 6.5]** – Awarded after successful completion of **one year** of study and all prescribed credits of one year following a four-year Bachelor's degree (Honours/Honours with Research).
- **Master's Degree [Level 7]** – after successful completion of **two years** of study and all prescribed credits of both years following a four-year Bachelor's degree

C. Integrated Five-Year Bachelor's/Master's Programmes

Students enrolled in integrated programmes shall have the option to **exit after the third year** with a **Bachelor's Degree**, with the possibility of lateral entry into a **two-year Master's programme** in another Higher Education Institution (HEI).

The nomenclature for Certificates, Diplomas, and Degrees corresponding to the various exit points for all programmes of the University shall be finalized based on the above framework.

If a student discontinues the programme in between an academic session rather than at the end of such academic year, the relevant qualification as per clauses (A) to (C) above shall be awarded based on the credits earned.

- (4) The students wishing to exit their academic programme before the completion of the programme must apply well in advance for exit, preferably before the start of the next academic year.
- (5) The structured framework for the Multiple Entry option for students who wish to re-enter their programme after a gap. This framework shall be customized for each programme, keeping in view its maximum permissible duration as specified by the UG and PG ordinance and mentioned below:
 - Maximum duration of the UG programme (4 years/8 semesters) can be extended upto 8 years.
 - Maximum duration of the UG programme (3 years/6 semesters) can be extended upto 6 years
 - Maximum duration of the PG programme (2 years/4 semesters) can be extended upto 4 years.

The credits earned shall remain valid for redemption for a maximum of 8/6/4 years depending on the programme.

- (6) Re-entry to a programme would refer to the process of entry into the next level of study by a student already enrolled in a programme of study of the University or its colleges, who exited after completion of the preceding level of study.

(A) Re-entry Framework for Four-Year Undergraduate Programmes

Students shall be permitted **re-entry** into the same programme of study and in the same college in which he/she has been enrolled, after exiting in between the programme, as per the following tables:


